Main Characteristics

- 1. Co-management
- 2. Sharing of Profits and Losses
- 3. Limited Duration



- 1. The Government can look to the resources of two (or more) companies to perform the work;
- 2. A minority joint venture member can exert more control over contract performance to protect its interests than in a traditional prime-sub relationship;
- 3. The joint venture parties receive favorable partnership income tax treatment; and
- 4. Participating in a joint venture may allow a company to avoid any perceived stigma associated with being a subcontractor to its competitors.



- 1. Lead Contractor gives up substantial control;
- 2. The participating contractors become joint and severally liable to third parties for the acts of their joint venture partners, including criminal acts;
- 3. The Government may view the joint venture as lacking a clear point of contract, thus raising concerns regarding control, authority, and accountability.

- 1. Opportunity to establish on-going working relationship with large firms.
- 2. Joint venture and subcontracting opportunities.
- 3. Advantages to mentor firms.
- 4. Provides exemptions from affiliation rules.

RECENT JOINT VENTURES ISSUES



- Program manager must be employed by small business at the time JV submits proposal Lance Bailey & Associates
- Strict compliance with 8(a) joint venture requirements, despite SBA approval sT Net/Apptis
- Appeals of size determination not dismissed as moot because contracting officer intends to leave award in place Ross Aviation
- Mentor Protégé/JV exemption to affiliation rule apply to JV as prime contractor; JV with large business mentor impermissible as subcontractor to DOE Labs
- When Mentor Protégé agreement ends, affiliation may arise on long term contracts or MACs disqualifying JV between mentor and protégé
