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#### Introduction



- The Office of Enforcement recognizes the enormous challenge of contract transition and associated uncertainties for the workforce
- Transition of contractors also presents enforcement challenges



#### **Transition Basics**



- Responsibility for compliance transfers at time of formal contract change
- Due diligence review should include a review of ongoing issues involving noncompliances (e.g., NTS reports)
- Work with HS-40 to disposition NTS reports



#### **Cautions**



- Liability for noncompliant conditions doesn't necessarily end at contract termination
- Declaration of a pre-existing condition doesn't automatically result in discretion or mitigation; case by case basis
  - ease of discovery
  - aggressiveness of corrective actions
  - barriers to achieving compliance



## **Recommendations for Incoming Contractors**



- Ensure corrective action commitments are acceptable
- For multi-contractor sites, ensure respective parties understand responsibilities for corrective actions
- Ensure ownership of corrective actions is clear to HS-40
