


WCH Summary of Work

- DOE prime contractor for the River Corridor Closure Contract at the Hanford Site to complete the safe, compliant, and efficient cleanup of the Columbia River Corridor
- Work includes:
 - D4 Project Demolition, deactivation, decontamination, decommission
 - Field remediation Sampling & analyzing site
 - Reactor interim safe storage
 - Waste operations Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility

WRPS Summary of Work

- Retrieve waste from 149 older single-shell tanks
- Transfer waste from the singleshell tanks to 28 more durable double-shell tanks
- Upgrade tank-farm facilities in preparation for waste feed to and from the Waste Treatment Plant
- Develop supplemental technologies and facilities for treatment and disposal of lowactivity waste
