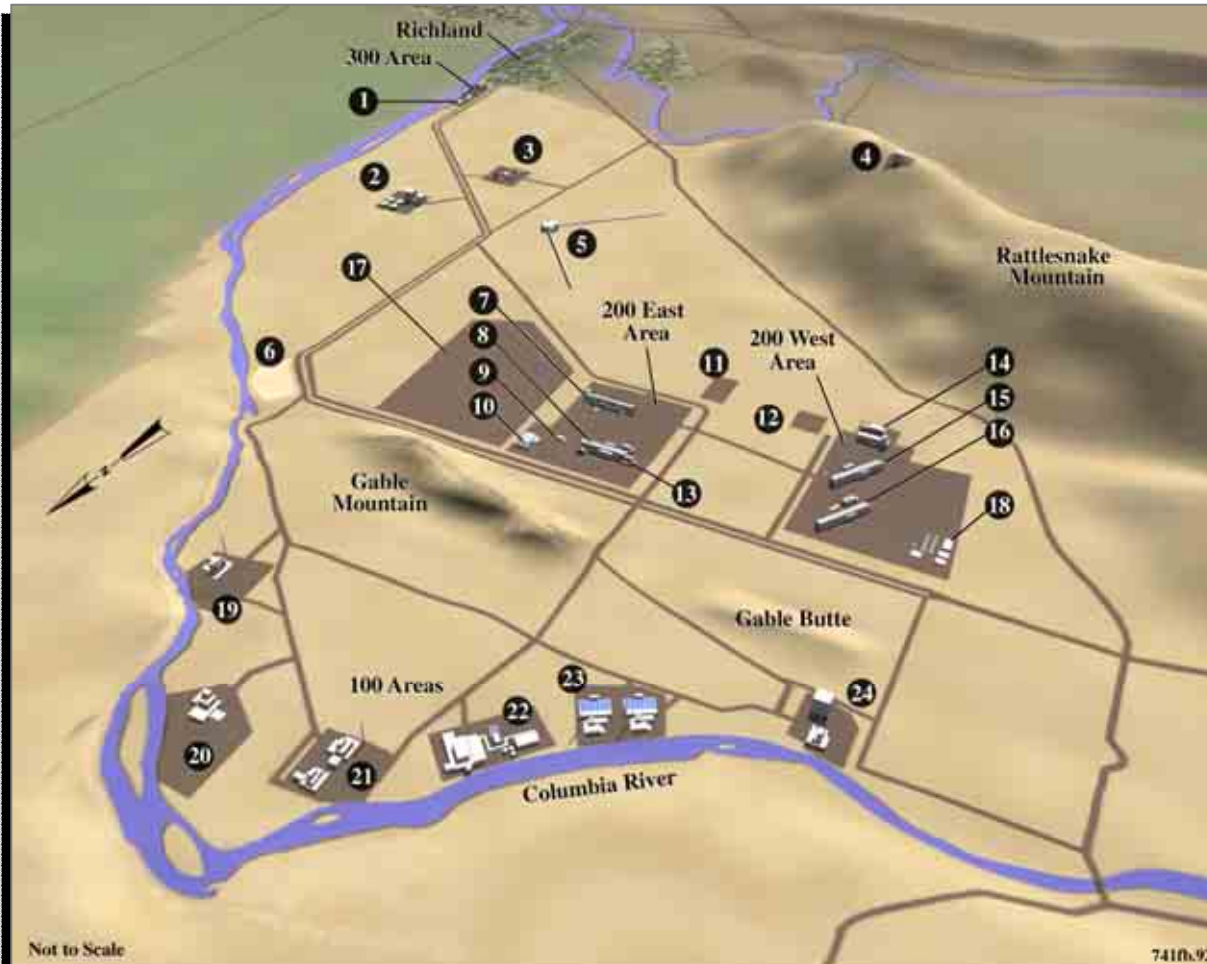

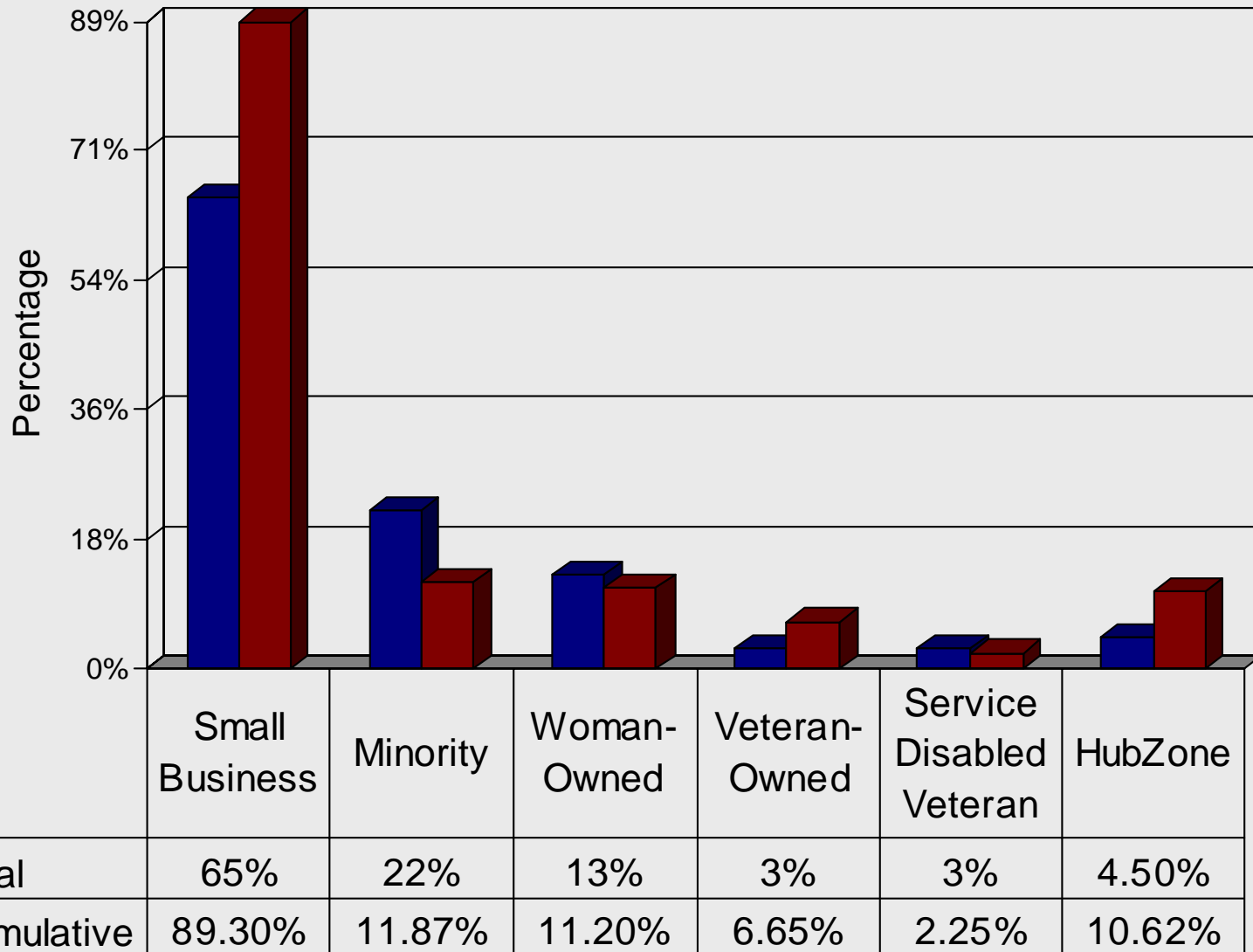


WCH Summary of Work

- Work includes:
 - D4 Project - Demolition, deactivation, decontamination, decommission
 - Field remediation - Sampling & analyzing site
 - Reactor interim safe storage
 - Waste operations - Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility

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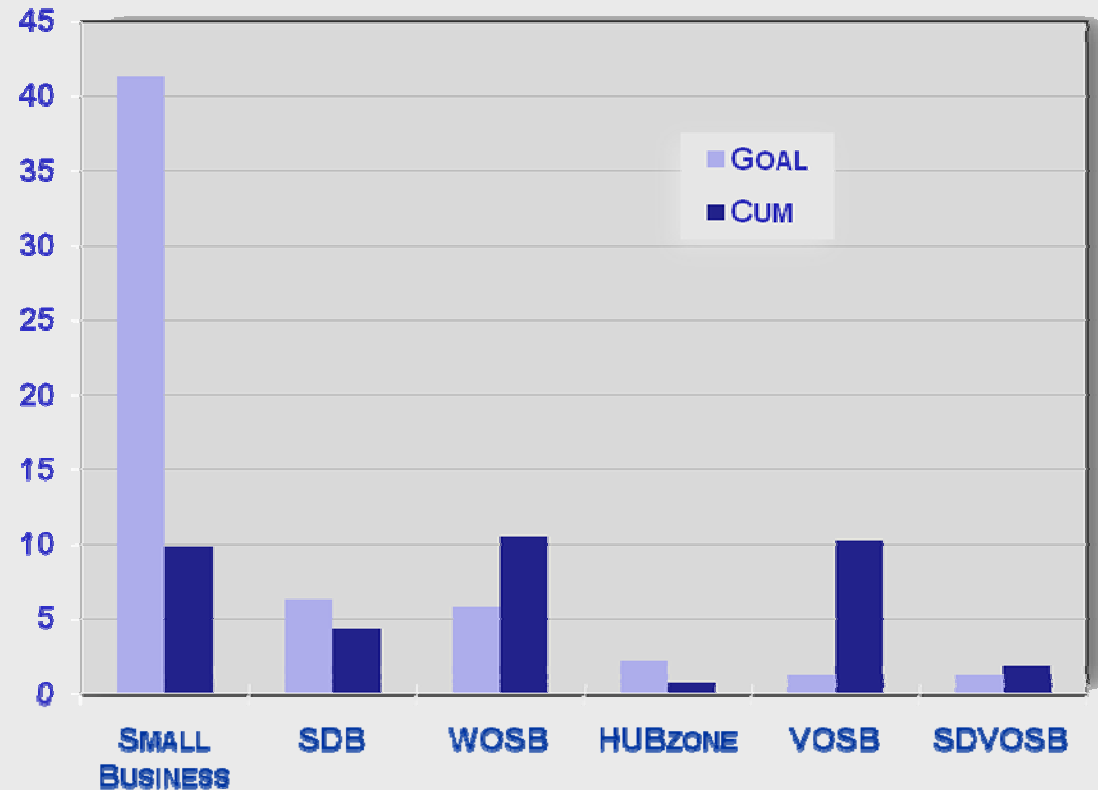
WRPS Summary of Work

- Retrieve waste from 149 older single-shell tanks
- Transfer waste from the single-shell tanks to 28 more durable double-shell tanks
- Upgrade tank-farm facilities in preparation for waste feed to and from the Waste Treatment Plant
- Develop supplemental technologies and facilities for treatment and disposal of low-activity waste
