- Began in Spring 2005 with Rosie Mathisen speaking at ETEBA Dinner Meeting

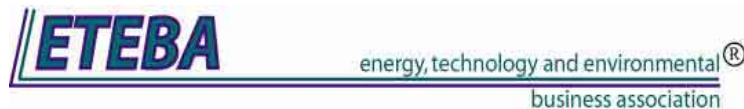
