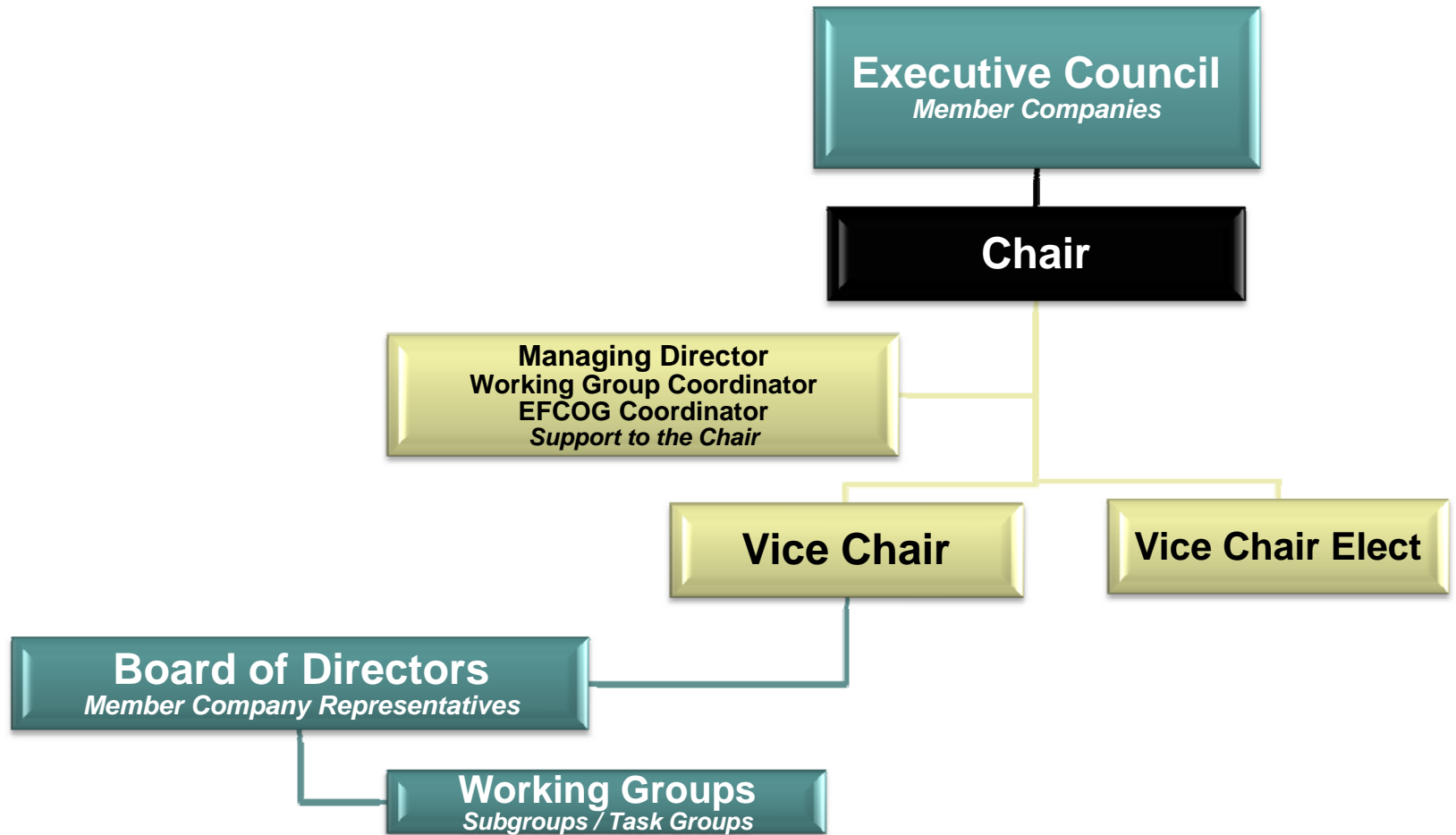
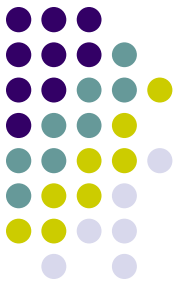


- Founded in 1991

- Approximately 1,000 participants annually in EFCOG activities

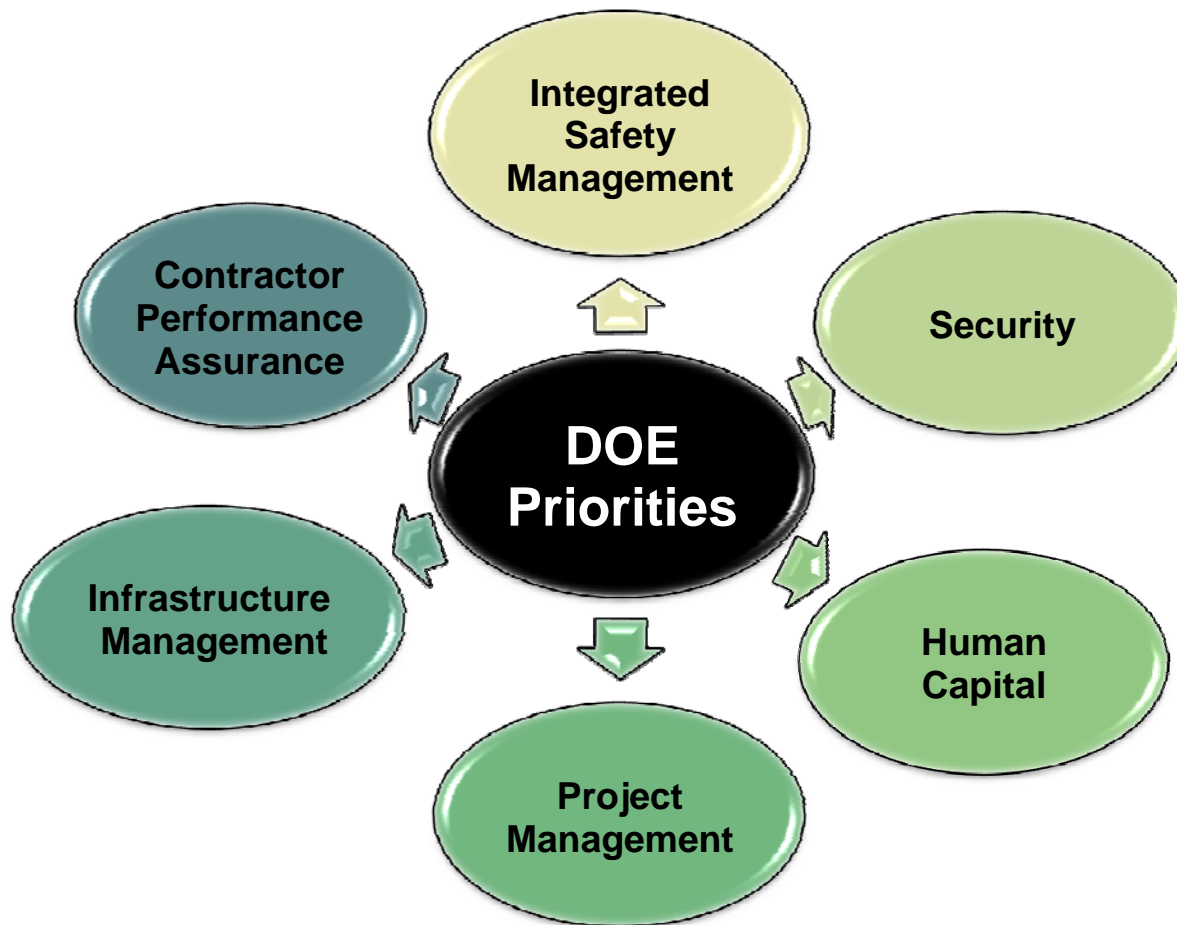
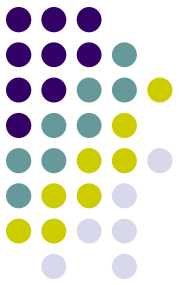

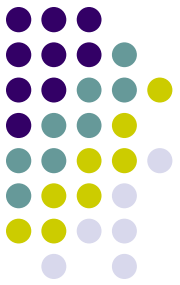


EFCOG's Organization

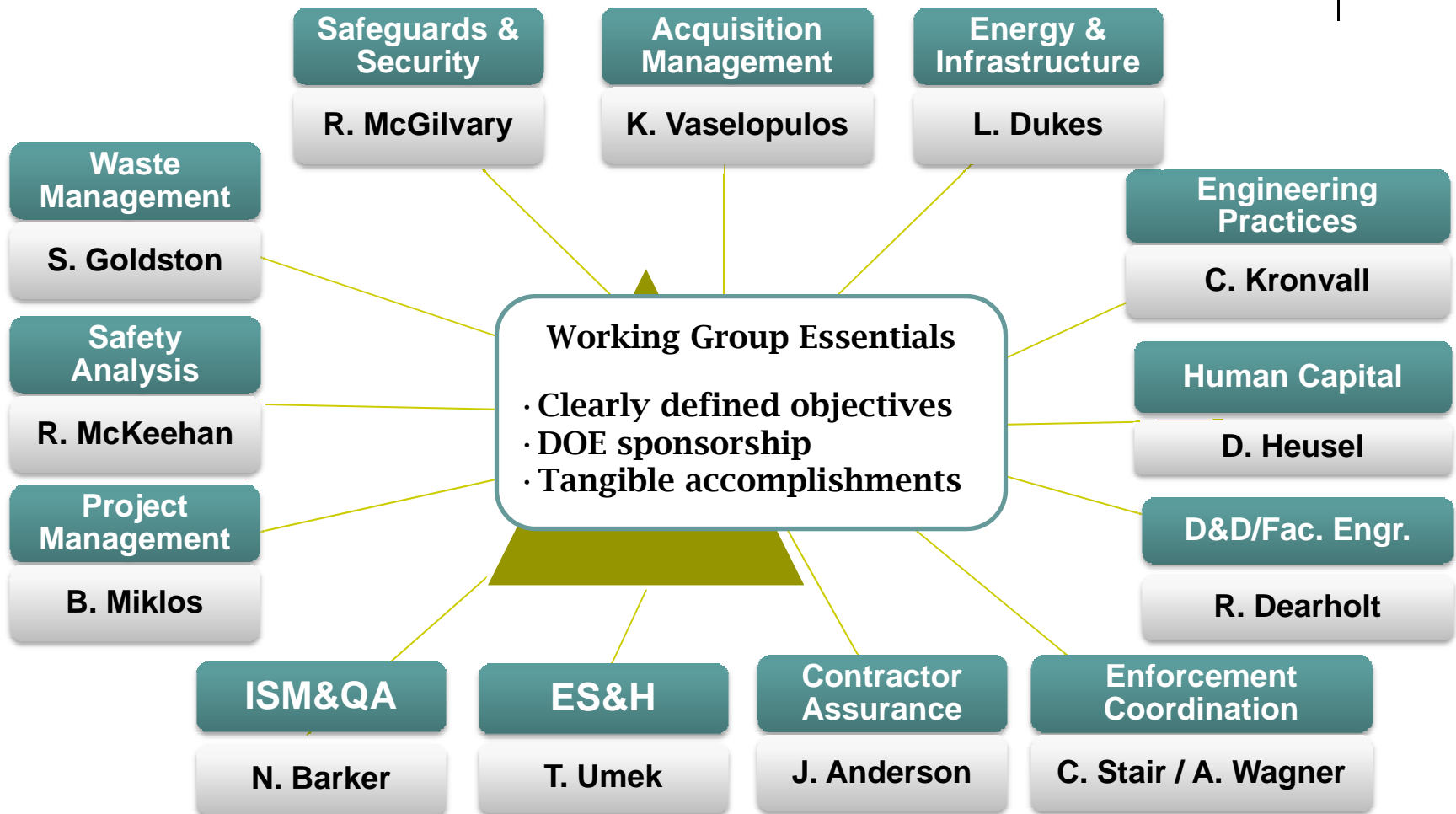

Recent EFCOG Activities/ Accomplishments



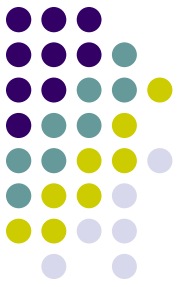
- Completed the Safety Culture improvement task with final recommendations to continue strengthening ISMS

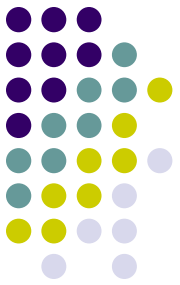

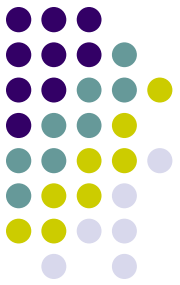
