## **IAEA** Mission

- IAEA is an independent intergovernmental organization:
  - that serves as the global focal point for nuclear cooperation;
  - assists its Member States in planning for and using nuclear science and technology for various peaceful purposes, and facilitates the transfer of such technology and
  - develops nuclear safety standards and promotes high levels of safety in nuclear applications
  - through its inspection system verifies compliance with the commitments, under the Non-Proliferation Treaty

## **IAEA and IFNEC Interactions**

- IAEA has been observer in IFNEC from the beginning
- IAEA is an active observer at the meetings of
  - Executive Committee
  - Steering Committee
  - Both WG: Infrastructure Development WG (IDWG) and Reliable Nuclear Fuel Services WG (RNFSWG)
- IAEA makes presentations and provides information on our activities
- IAEA has participated in workshops on specific topics: SMRs, Emergency preparedness, HRD for nuclear power infrastructure

## Forum for discussion

- All IFNEC members are also IAEA members
- IFNEC has smaller membership, but:
  - more focused to nuclear power
  - Meetings of IFNEC countries provide useful forum for conversations at executive level
  - Exclusivity of membership allows well targeted discussions on future of nuclear power
- IAEA membership is broader and more heterogeneous, meetings of IAEA MSs address broader issues



- IAEA is ready to continue its role as an observer in IFNEC
- IAEA is open to further discussions how to maximize the use of contributions for the benefit of MSs
