EM Journey to Excellence

Goal #3: Improve project, budget and contract management with the objective of delivering results on time, within cost, and with world-class technical competencies.

Key Strategies

- Establish an internal quality assurance process
- Improve and expand the use of independent reviews
- Strengthen the integration of acquisition and project management
- Establish a policy for performance of EM's portfolio of non-capital asset operations activities
- Become a stronger owner
- Develop EM-specific cost estimating policy, guidance and databases
- Provide training in contract and project management
- Make effective use of small and minority owned businesses
- Shift away from M&O culture



EM Journey to Excellence

Key Success Measures

- Achieve EM overall prime contract goal of 5% at each site
- Approve 80% of contract performance baselines within 180 days
- Finalize 80% of change orders within 180 days
- Negotiate 90% of contract changes in advance of Acquisition Executive approval of baseline changes
- Implement partnering Policy to transform contract management
- Conduct a Contracting Summit
- Complete 90% of capital projects within 10% of original cost and schedule baselines
- Ensure 90% of projects have FPDs certified at the appropriate level assigned to projects no later than CD-3
- Ensure 90% of contractors managing capital asset projects maintain EVMS certification
- Negotiate all project changes requiring contract modification prior to AE approval
- Conduct Project Peer Review and develop/implement corrective action plans
- Accomplish Project Peer Review and develop/implement corrective action
- Perform complex-wide strategic planning analysis of costs, benefits and other impacts to cleanup schedules and approaches
- Establish an X-Team to streamline reporting requirements

Best Practices - Pre-Award

- Improved the acquisition planning process to expedite release of Requests for Proposals
- Issued more robust Request for Proposals to include draft Performance Evaluation Measurement Plans
- Reduced volume of pricing information required from offerors
- Revised acquisition process to ensure all parties are informed and engaged to make transition more efficient
- Established an acquisition improvement program to capture and apply to future procurements
- Increased transparency by working more closely with industry during the procurement process
- Improved debriefing process to share technical and cost evaluation documentation

Best Practices - Post-Award

- Implemented fee and pricing structures to protect tax payer interests, such as "claw-back provisions" and cost ceilings.
- Changing the award fee environment to better focus contractors on mission priorities
- Improved accuracy and timeliness of reporting of contractor past performance information in the Contract Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS)
- Improved alignment between the Performance Management Baseline and the contract estimated cost.
- Improved contract transition through implementation of formal partnering sessions

Best Practice - Partnering

Purpose


To increase interactions with internal and external stakeholders to foster better communication and problem solving, and mutual trust

- Contractor must be successful for the EM program to be successful
- Established Guidelines for Partnering-based Contract Management
- EM Policy is to establish partnering agreements on all contracts
- Conduct Partnering Workshops on all contacts
- Include a Partnering Clause in EM contracts
- Nine (9) Partnering Agreements have been completed to date



Contract and Project Baselines

- Submit initial Contract Performance Baseline within 90 day of contract award
- Submit overall Contract Performance Baseline within 180 days of contract transition


