Should advocacy address sustainability?

All sustainable businesses, regardless of size, benefit DOE over the long run as they:

- Contribute to improved mission, project and workforce stability
- Maintain workforce capabilities & safety culture
- Transfer experience among DOE jobs
- Decrease project risk & increase project efficiency
- Improve long-term cost effectiveness for DOE

- ➤ When should DOE consider contracting directly with a small business?



When should DOE consider contracting directly with a small business?

Only when the scope fits the strengths of the small business model. It demands:

- Providing technical strength and depth
- Avoiding risk to mission success
- Accomplishing seamless workforce transition
- Implementing adequate ISMS and QAPP
- Demonstrating adequate financial stability and business systems infrastructure



Asking Questions -- The DOE Marketplace

- What limits small business prosperity?
- How does DOE small business prime contracting compare to DOE contractor subcontracting?
- Does either contracting method affect operational or economic stability of a small business?
- Does either contracting method indicate sustainability is favored?



Does either contracting method indicate sustainability is favored?

"Yes" when priming or managed tasks and "No" according to recent trends. Sustainability requires:

- Focus on value added & not strictly cost
- Internal technical strength & depth
- Standalone, comprehensive infrastructure
- External communication & integration
- Transferable capabilities
- Managed-task experience
- Resource control & staffing flexibility
- Contract stability

- What are the contracting risks?
- What are the financial risks?
- > What would improve small business contracting?



What would improve small business contracting?

- Emphasize best overall value
- Assess value that is beyond the project
- Reward commitment & promote sustainability
 - Focus on long-term best interests of DOE
 - Operate safely with predictable quality
 - Provide sufficient employee benefits
 - Demonstrate adequate infrastructure
 - Contribute to their local community
