

Synopsis

- 75% of total applicable agreements awarded to small businesses
- > Total enterprise-wide agreement spend was \$5.4M
- Total enterprise-wide small business agreement spend was \$5.4M (100% of total)
- Actual savings rate was 16.6% when using these enterprise-wide small business agreements




