

- Prepare now for future cleanup at Y-12 and ORNL

 - ✓ Design/build/operate Mercury Treatment Facility
 - ✓ Complete design of facility to treat TRU sludge








East Tennessee Technology Park

- Gaseous diffusion facility built in the early 1940s as part of the Manhattan Project
- Enriched uranium for defense and commercial purposes
- Operations at the site shut down in 1984
- Now a cleanup site transitioning to a private-sector industrial park
