Availability of Qualified Resources



- Internal to Licensee
 - Oversight of Decommissioning Contractor(s)
 - > Internal experience available?
 - > Operating vs. "deconstruction" culture
 - Impact of reduced staffing if deferred have you kept the right staff?
- Decommissioning Contractor
 - Limited pool of decommissioningng experienced resources
 - Limited recent/current decommissioning experience

Availability of Decommissioning Funds



- Adequate Funds Available and Approved for Use
 - Regulatory Approval
 - Deferral allows for fund to grow
 - What can funds be used for "in preparation for" decommissioning?

State and Local Involvement



- Public Stakeholder and Community Involvement
 - Pro or Con on immediate vs deferral?
 - Permits and Licenses
 - Long Term On site Dry Fuel Storage perception vs Fuel Pool Storage
- Availability of Waste Disposal Sites
 - Interim Centralized Storage Facilities
 - Federal Waste Repository
