
## The United Kingdom's nuclear programme

- 5 new civil nuclear plants by 2030
- Large programme of decommissioning work 19 sites
- Astute and Successor submarines



## Sustaining the United Kingdom's nuclear skills

- Need to recruit 8,600 people per year
- Reskill existing workforce



- » Tier 3 (20+ years' experience) subject matter experts
- » Tier 2 (10+ years' experience) need documented combination of qualifications and sector experience
- » Tier 1 (without special nuclear skills) require awareness for nuclear quality and safety standards


