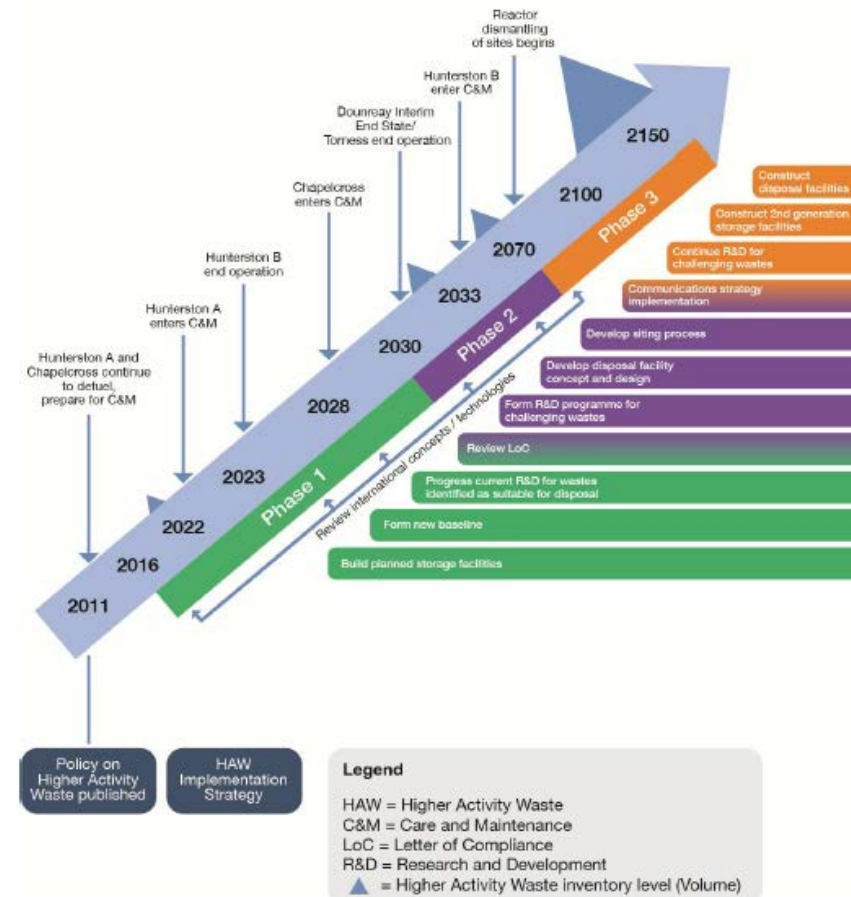


Implementation strategy for Scotland's policy on higher activity radioactive waste

Illustrative HAW Strategy Timeline

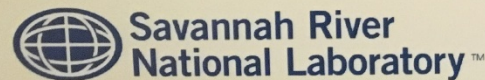



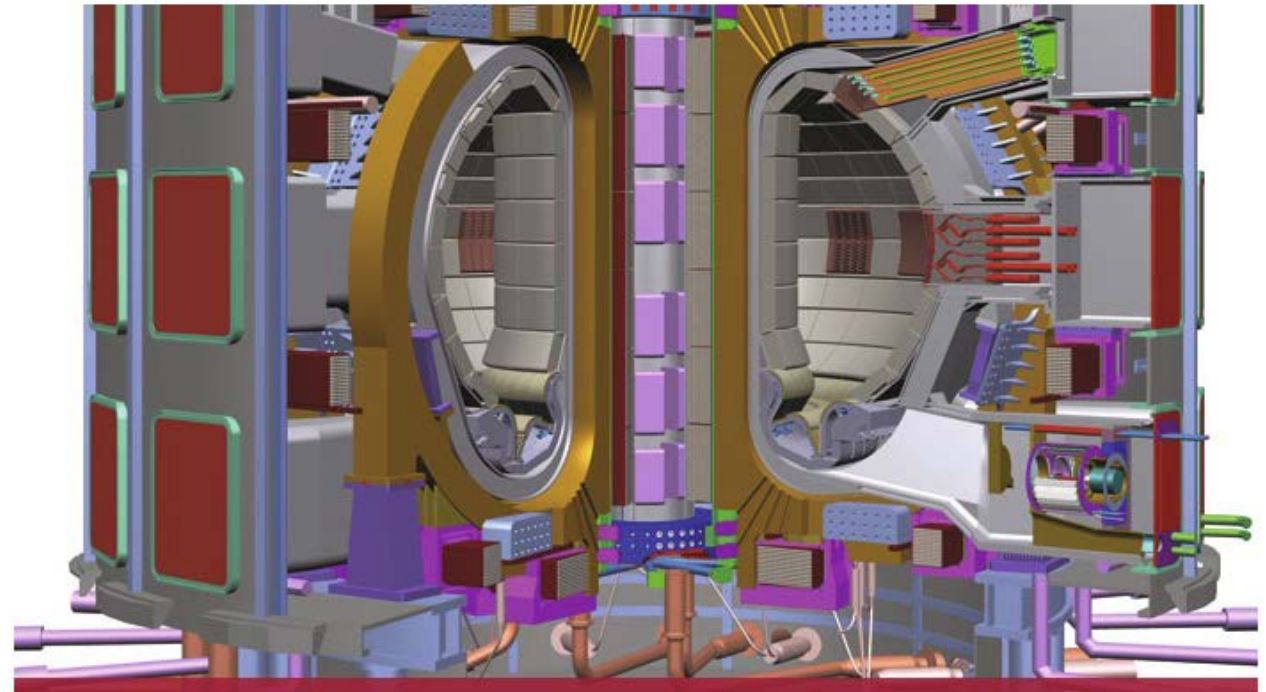
